Greetings, Bulldogs:

This past week was the first week of implementation of the Pennsylvania Department of Health's August 31, 2021, <u>Masking Order</u>. We viewed this week as a transition week while we determined how best to enforce the mandate. I truly appreciate the cooperation and understanding of our Bulldog families and community; **most of all, I appreciate the respect shown to our building administrators, faculty, and staff.**

As of the date/time of this communication, the Masking Order remains in effect. The transition period will end on Wednesday, September 15th, and the expectation is that all students will wear face coverings beginning on Thursday, September 16th.

There is also additional information below about quarantining.

Work Session Meeting

We are anticipating a larger than typical audience for next Tuesday's (September 14th @ 6:30 PM) Work Session. I can tell you that the Board will be discussing the PADoH Masking Order and how it impacts our District. In light of this, I would like to share information on meeting conduct and public comment.

- The School Board and Administration welcome community members to public meetings of the Board. The meeting will be held in the Administration Building Boardroom.
- The Board of School Directors encourages comments from the community during the public comment portion of the meeting as noted on the Agenda.
 - The meeting agenda and all pertinent documents are available to the press and public at the meetings.
 - Agendas are also available to the public on the Monday prior to the meeting via BoardDocs. Please visit the <u>Board page</u> of our website for more information.
- Typically, we allow up to five minutes per person for public comment. If we find there are a
 significant number of attendees asking to provide public comment, we will adjust that timing to
 allow not less than three minutes, but no more than five minutes depending on the number of
 attendees in order to allow as many attendees to speak as possible.

- If you are planning to attend virtually <u>via Zoom</u>, and wish to provide a comment, we ask that you email your comment to us prior to the meeting no later than noon on Tuesday, September 14th, and it will be read by the presiding officer. Again, this is to allow us to plan for timing.
 - Please send your intent to comment to: <u>BulldogMail@wyasd.org</u>.
 - Include your full name and address.
- If you are planning to provide public comment in person, you will be asked to fill out a public comment card (found on the sign-in table) and place it in the basket on the table. Again, this is to allow us to plan for timing.
- The presiding officer will begin public comment with those attending the meeting in person.
- Board policy indicates that the Board will take questions and concerns under advisement and issue a response after due deliberation. A representative of the Board or District administration will contact the individual at the phone number or email provided to share the Board's response.
- The Board does not allow complaints of a personal nature to be initiated at a public meeting.
 Any such complaints will be referred to the Superintendent.
- No placards or banners will be permitted within the meeting room without prior approval.
