



WEST YORK CYBER ACADEMY Online Learning Time Expectations by Grade Level 2020-2021

The West York Area School District has created a program to promote flexibility and options for classes that can be taken online. The program is designed to provide continuity of education for all students taught by West York teachers and using the curriculum adopted by West York. Students will be provided with materials to ensure consistency and similar experiences to classroom such as: journals, notebooks, manipulatives, letter tiles, etc. Times listed represent a total of online and offline minutes representative of a “typical” school day.

Wallace Elementary - Kindergarten and 1st Grade

ELA - 155 minutes

- Guided Reading/Word Work/Daily 5/Response to Reading - 60 min
 - This includes conferencing with students, small groups, and formative assessments
- Interactive Read Aloud - 15 min
- Shared Reading - 10 min
- Reading Mini Lesson - 10 min
- Writing - 30 min
- Foundations - 30 min

Math - 60 min

Content (Science/Social Studies) - 30 min

Encore - 30 min--one activity per Encore (art, music, PE, media/STEM) every other week (2 per week)

Lincolnway Elementary - 2nd and 3rd Grade

ELA - 140 minutes

- Guided Reading/Word Work/Daily 5/Response to Reading - 20 min
 - This includes conferencing with students, small groups, and formative assessments
- Interactive Read Aloud/Shared Reading - 45 min
- Reading Mini Lesson - 15 min
- Writing - 30 min
- Foundations - 30 min

Math - 75 min

Content (Science/Social Studies) - 30 min

Encore - 30 min--one activity per Encore (art, music, PE, media/STEM) every other week (2 per week)

Trimmer Elementary - 4th and 5th Grade

ELA - 120 min

Math - 75 min

Content (Science/Social Studies) - 45 min

1:1/small group academic time (unleashed) - 15 min

Encore - 45 min--one activity per Encore (art, music, PE, media/STEM) every other week (2 per week)

Middle School - 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade

ELA - 75 min

Math - 75 min

Science/Social Studies (1 per semester) - 75 min

Exploratory - 40 min

High School - 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th Grade

5 blocks for 65 minutes following required and elective courses

- 1 semester ($\frac{1}{2}$ year courses)
- Students are able to take 10 courses (credits)/year
