Superintendent Evaluation | 2017-18

On Tuesday, June 12, 2018, the West York Area School District Board of School Directors met in Executive Session to conduct an end-of-year performance evaluation of Dr. Todd M. Davies, Superintendent of Schools. The School Directors concluded that Dr. Davies had met the Goals and Objectives as outlined below for the 2017-18 school year.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

Goal Category 1: Academics, Student Growth and Achievement. *Description:* This category requires the superintendent to foster a school culture conducive to teaching and learning, and design and/or support systemic measures which help students meet academic growth targets, evaluate instructional programs and efficiently utilizes technology as part of the curriculum.

Goal Category 2: Communication and Engagement. *Description:* This category requires the superintendent to design and/or support systemic measures which enable effective, clear and consistent communication channels to internal and external stakeholders.

Goal Category 3: Safe and Caring Environment, Culture and Climate. *Description:* This category requires the superintendent to design and/or support systemic measures which create a culture that is physically and emotionally safe, and equally accessible to all students, staff and community members.

Goal Category 4: Budget, Finance and Operations. *Description:* This category requires the superintendent to design and/or support systemic measures to ensure the ethical, efficient and strategic use of fiscal, operational, human and capital resources to ensure long-term financial health and stability.
